Speak up about your class background. Ask others about theirs.

Work to end poverty 100%

(so everyone has a good place to live, good food, health care, and ...)

Work to end capitalism.

Ask yourself:

Is your share of the world's (finite) resources a fair share?

Think – what would it take to meet everyone's needs?

What will you do about it?

Be brave – call people on classist remarks (class attacks).

Respect cultural differences.

A living wage, and a maximum wage: help make it happen.

Find others who want to end classism, and help each other.
